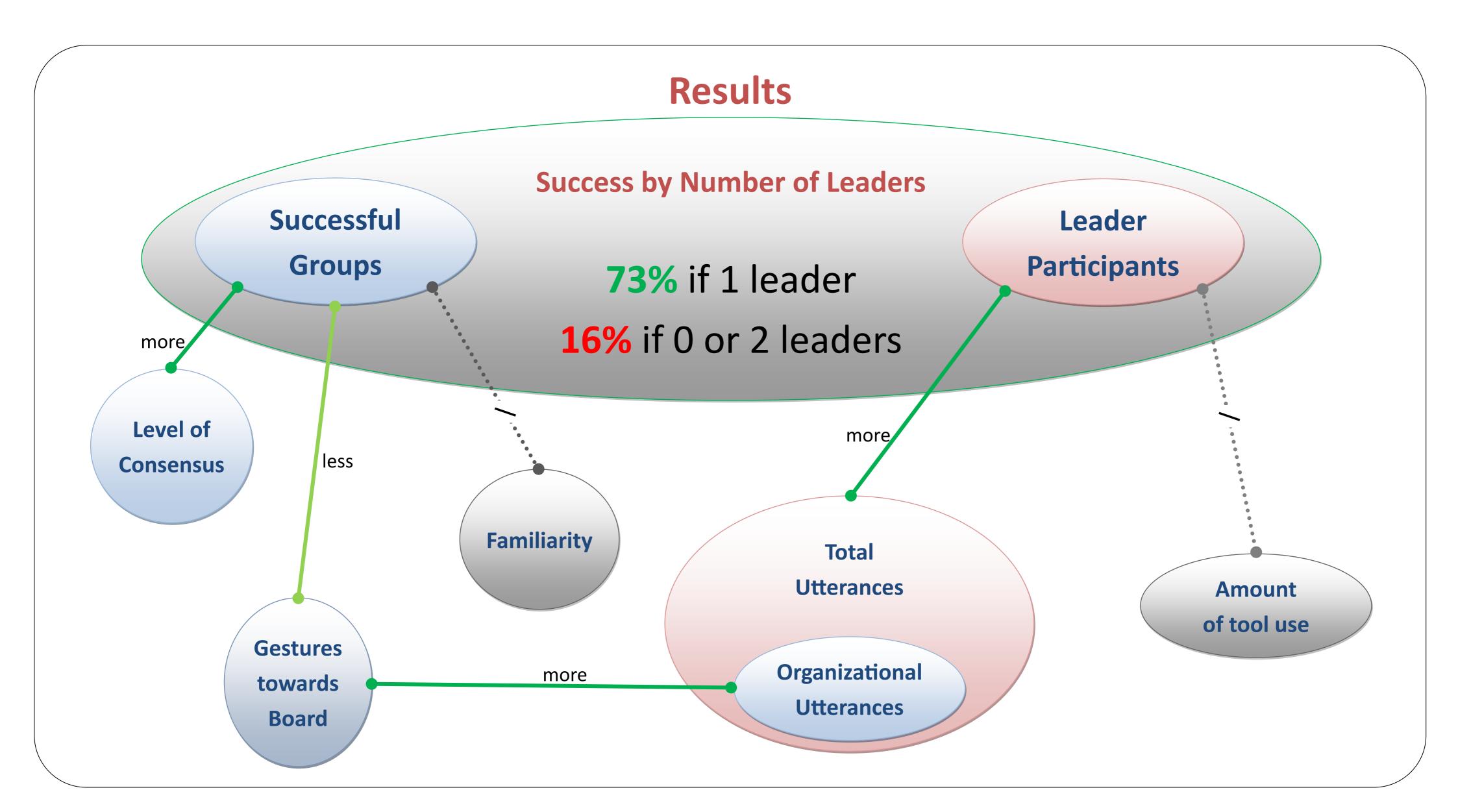
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## Conclusions

- Prior acquaintance has no effect on task success
- Initial evidence of more success with a single leader than with no or more leaders . More analysis on other process variables
