

## BORDERS OF THE BARENTS SEA

The Barents Region consist of the body of the Barents Sea itself and the following 13 countries:  
 • In Norway: Tromsø, Finnmark  
 • In Sweden: Västerbotten, Norrbotten  
 • In Finland: Lapland, Northern Ostrobothnia, Kainuu  
 • In Russia: Murmansk Oblast, Arkhangelsk Oblast, Komi Republic, Republic of Karelia, Nenets Autonomous Okrug

## EXTENT OF THE BARENTS SEA

To the south: northern Norwegian and Russian coast  
 • To the west: border to the Greenland Sea  
 • To the north: border to the North Cape to Svalbard, running through Bear Island (N)  
 • To the north: Svalbard (N), Franz Joseph Land archipelagoes (R)  
 • To the east: Novaya Zemlya (R).

## DATA OF THE BARENTS SEA

- Area: 1,405,000 km<sup>2</sup>
- Average depth: 230m
- Max Depth: 600m (Bear Island, French Fr.)
- Average temperature: 0°C (Barents Sea)
- Gas reserves: 30% of the world (est.)
- Oil reserves: 25% of the world (est.)
- Population: 5.5 million
- Number of inhabitants: population: 70,000 (est.)
- Climates: subarctic
- Average summer air temperature: +5° to +15°C (SW)
- Average winter air temperature: -10°C (N) and 0°C (SW)
- Annual precipitation: 500 mm (S) and 250mm (N)
- Winter night (complete darkness): 70 days/year
- Summer night (24 hours daylight): 70 days/year
- Most important industries: Fishing, Mining, Oil and Gas
