This special issue contains 35 best papers accepted for the XXV edition of the Computer Graphics International Conference, CGI 2007, held in Petrópolis, near Rio de Janeiro, from May 30th to June 2nd 2007. The CGI has been organized every year since 1983 by the Computer Graphics Society (CGS). This year the interest group on computer graphics and image processing of the Brazilian Computer Society (SBC) was also involved.

In addition to these 35 full papers, the CGI program committee also accepted 25 full papers for publication in the CGI proceedings from 145 submitted papers. The reviewing process was based on the evaluation provided by

at least three reviewers per paper. The conference included one invited talk from Prof. Przemyslaw Prusinkiewicz, and three tutorials coordinated by Dr. Nadia Magnenat-Thalmann, Dr. Daniel Thalmann, Dr. Victor Zordan and Dr. Brian Wyvill.
