## CYBERSPACE:

REALITY IN WHICH THE CARTESIAN NOTION OF SPACE AS AN EMPTY, THREE DIMENSIONAL CONTAINER, IS NO MORE. IN CYBERSPACE, NOTIONS OF DISTANCES AND OF TIME ARE WRAPPED TO CREATE A NEW UNDERSTANDING OF SPACE AS A RELATIVIST REALITY. LOCALIZATION IS NO MORE USED TO DESCRIBE POSITION, AND TIME IS NOT USED TO CLASSIFY INFORMATION

PHYSICAL SPACE:

REALITY RULED BY OUR TRADITIONAL UNDERSTANDING OF SPACE, IN WHICH DISTANCES ARE USED AS A MEASURE OF SPACE TO ANALYSE OUR ENVIRONMENT. THE TRADITIONAL TOOLS OF ARCHITECTURAL REPRESENTATION ARE USED TO DESCRIBE REALITY.
