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# Correction to: Sex-specific changes in gene expression in response to estrogen pollution around the onset of sex differentiation in grayling (*Salmonidae*)

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**Correction to: *BMC Genomics* (2019) 20:583**  
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Following publication of the original article [1], the authors reported an error in the Results section. Under the heading “Gene ontology enrichment analysis”, they wrote:

“In females at the juvenile stage, GO terms associated to glycogen metabolism (glycogen metabolic processes, insulin receptor signalling pathway) and to heart development were enriched for genes down-regulated under EE2.”

This text should be corrected as follows:

“In females at the juvenile stage, GO terms associated to glycogen metabolism (glycogen metabolic processes, insulin receptor signalling pathway) and to heart development were enriched for genes up-regulated under EE2.”

The enrichment as noted in Table S4 remains correct.
